Guidelines for the Selection of Recipients For Mechanics Technical Training

1. A candidate must file an application to be eligible to receive an award.
2. A member of the immediate family of a Foundation member may not be considered as a candidate for an award.
3. A candidate must not have been in serious trouble with school or civil activities.
4. Each recipient of an award will be selected on the basis of application received.
5. Each recipient of an award must agree in writing to use the award only for the purpose of improving or developing his/her capabilities through continued education.
6. The selection committee which selects the recipient(s) of the award(s) will be composed of the Board of Directors of the Foundation.
7. The number and the amount of the awards will be determined by the Board of Directors of the Foundation and will be based upon the amount of the earnings from the fund investments.
8. Each award will be paid directly to the schools in which the recipient is enrolled.
9. The recipient(s) of the award(s) will be announced at the Annual Convention of the ***Mid-America Equipment Retailers Association***.
10. Foundation members are urged to publicize the availability of the awards to all surrounding high schools in their area so as to ensure that the class of recipients will be sufficiently broad to fulfill a public charitable purpose.
11. To prevent an award from being characterized as compensation, presentation of an award will not be contingent upon the recipient's legal obligation to work in the industry either during the time that the recipient is enrolled in the training program or upon completion of the training program.
12. The selection committee will not discriminate on the basis of sex, religion or national origin.
